



## SCOUTS CODE of CONDUCT

### Responsibilities:

- Carry your ID card and show appropriately when approaching any club officials or indeed referees.
- Engage with all potential stakeholders in a respectful and mannerly fashion in relation to a young player, club and their parents/guardians.
- Accept both the guidelines and the spirit of the rules that define and govern Club Academy Scotland Pro-Youth Football.
- Ensure you follow St Johnstone Football Club's Protocol for Approaching Players, Parents and Club.
- If, when seeking permission to contact a player and parent/guardian is refused, then the club shall contact the Secretary of the Scottish Youth FA with a full explanation of events.
- On no account approach and make contact with a young player directly.
- Always lead by example and do not use foul or abusive threatening language.
- Avoid any form of harassment towards any individual. This includes harassment on sex, race or disability; note this list is not exhaustive.
